




AND SO! & ALORS!

Very interested in the world of film and video he took in 2004 tofeature "Maaking off" by Fed Bouzid and nominated to the Golden Tanit Carthage film, dance in "Fire-Men" in 2006 and participatesthe video project (DANCERS) Bud Blumenthal.


In 2007 he joined Co. Osmosis Physical Dance Theater and Dancein "Highway Of The Sun", "TRANSIT", "(There) stars in the world" as well as for the "Hotel Room Dance International" in Germany.

He enriches his career in dancing and meeting various other French and European artists such

as choreographers Hela Fattoumi and Eric Lamoureux, Emmanuelle Huynh, the Company Chatha, "theBallet C de la B", "Ultima Vez."

It recently established a solo "Maktoub". He founded the Collectiveparallel Upper Underground Crew in Tunis, which will certainlyparticipate in various projects in collaboration with local companies. The group was soon spotted for her work primarily oriented.


is a young company of dancers from Tunisian Culture Tunisian Hip Hop and direct witnesses of the revolution.
